Special Recognition for the
Honorable L B Hunt

- WHEREAS**, The Honorable L B Hunt was born on November 15, 1924, and is being honored by his community for his military service, his service to his church and to his community, and;
- WHEREAS**, Early in the life of Mr. L B Hunt, not only did he experience the hardship of the Great Depression, but also saw the invasion and start of the Second World War, and;
- WHEREAS**, Mr. L B Hunt, due to a sense of duty and pride in America, entered into this great conflict on September 29, 1944, and;
- WHEREAS**, Mr. L B Hunt served honorably in Company A, 307th Infantry Regiment in the 77th Division on Okinawa as a Specialist, E-5, and;
- WHEREAS**, Due to his honorable service, Mr. L B Hunt was awarded the Asiatic Specific Service Medal with One Bronze Service Star, and;
- WHEREAS**, Mr. L B was also awarded the Philippine Liberation Service Medal with One Bronze Service Star, and;
- WHEREAS**, furthermore, Mr. L B Hunt was awarded the World War II Victory Medal and the Army Occupation Medal, as well as the Good Conduct Medal, and;
- WHEREAS**, Mr. L B Hunt served his country and tribe by serving over 20 years in the United States Army, and;
- WHEREAS**, During this time, Mr. L B Hunt also served honorably in the Korean War, Vietnam and the Cuban Crisis, before his honorable discharge on February 3, 1965, and;
- WHEREAS**, Mr. L B Hunt's reputation for being a devote Christian, and member of the Shannon Assembly of God is well known, and established by the care and love displayed here today.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED** by the Chairman of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina that the Honorable L B Hunt is honored for his commitment, sacrifice and loyalty to not only the United States of America, his Tribe, but also to the world by his service to protect against tyranny and evil during his military service.
- BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED** that the Chairman of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina publicly recognizes the Honorable L B Hunt for his character, leadership, and integrity.
- BE IT FINALLY PROCLAIMED** by the Chairman of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina that this day, the 21st day of November 2009, is the Honorable L B Hunt day in the land of the Lumbee.
