- Only original unpublished writings will be accepted
- Entries are limited to 3 pieces per writer
- Name of writing, author's name, number of words (be sure of word count!), age group and category must appear on top right hand corner. If this does not appear, works will be disqualified.
- Completed registration forms must accompany each writing entry
- Typed, double spaced - front page only on 8 ½ x 11 paper, with multiple pages stapled. Page numbers on right hand bottom corner. No e-mail entries accepted.
- Entries must be presented to the writing coordinator on Thursday, March 11 between the hours 2 -6 p.m. **No late entries accepted.**
