## **“RED VOICES RISING OUT OF THE PAST GIVING WISDOM SONGS FOR THE PRESENT”**

**WHEREAS**, The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina, a recognized American Indian Tribe of the State of North Carolina, subject to the Constitution of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina and its inherent powers of self-government; and

**WHEREAS**, Article VII, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina delegates all legislative authority to the Tribal Council; and

**WHEREAS**, The Tribal Council of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina has the authority to approve, adopt, and amend the annual fiscal year budget and budget process; and

**WHEREAS**, The Tribal Council is responsible for overseeing, reviewing budget variances throughout the fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, The Tribal Council of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina reserves the right to amend the budget as deemed appropriate to maintain a balanced budget; and


**WHEREAS**, The Department of Youth Services has identified a grant solicitation to assist tribal youth programs; and


**WHEREAS**, There will be one “Red Voices” site to visit known as Harper’s Ferry with historical significance. This grant is requesting \$5,000.00 for one year from the Minneapolis Foundation’s Native Americans in Philanthropy GenIndigenous Response Fund .

**THEREFORE**, Be it enacted by the Tribal Council of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina the Youth Services Department of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina is hereby authorized to pursue the following grant opportunity referred to as the **“RED VOICES RISING OUT OF THE PAST GIVING WISDOM SONGS FOR THE PRESENT”** through the Minneapolis Foundation’s Native Americans in Philanthropy GenIndigenous Response Fund in the amount up to \$5,000.00.
