WHEREAS, The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina ("Lumbee Tribe") is a recognized American Indian Tribe of the State of North Carolina, subject to the Constitution of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina and its inherent powers and self-government, and;

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section1 of the Tribal Constitution delegates all legislative authority to the Tribal Council of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina, and;

WHEREAS, The Lumbee Tribal Council created the Health and Human Services Committee to promote the health and well-being of the Lumbee people, and to address health disparities among the Lumbee people, and;

WHEREAS, Exposure to environmental adversities disproportionately affects American Indian Men and is associated with higher cardiovascular disease morbidity and mortality, and;

WHEREAS, University of NC at Chapel Hill has sought to partner with the Lumbee Tribe of NC to gather data to 1) understand the relationships between environmental adversities, emotional stress, and traditional cultural practices from the perspectives of American Indian Men; 2) examine the association between particulate matter and cardiovascular-associated inflammation in American Indian Men; and 3) examine the associations between emotional states and cardiovascular-associated inflammation in American Indian Men, and;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, The Health and Human Services Committee and the 2020 Lumbee Tribal Council does hereby support "University of NC at Chapel Hill Research on Environmental Exposures and Cardiovascular Health in American Indian Men (RE-CLAIM) Project"
