WHEREAS, The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina ("Lumbee Tribe") is a recognized American Indian Tribe of the State of North Carolina, subject to the Constitution of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina ("Tribal Constitution") and its inherent powers and self-government, and;

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section1 of the Tribal Constitution delegates all legislative authority to the Tribal Council of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina ("Tribal Council"), and;

WHEREAS, The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina, a recognized Tribe of the State of North Carolina Subject to the Constitution of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina and its inherent powers of self-government; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section of the Constitution of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina delegates all legislative authority to the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, The Lumbee Tribal Council has the authority and responsibility to protect and foster the education, culture, history, and heritage of the Lumbee Tribe and Lumbee tribal members; and

WHEREAS, Due to the deadly and contagious coronavirus, Lumbee students have been mandated to a remote school setting rather than the traditional school setting; and

WHEREAS, Due to safety precautions and protection from the coronavirus, Lumbee students are instructed to receive their education virtually through the North Carolina Public School system; and

WHEREAS, Many children and educators live in rural and remote areas where internet service is either inaccessible or nonexistent, resulting in great loss of a quality education that our children deserve; and

THEREFORE, Be it resolved, the Tribal Council of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina does hereby, support and agree to petition local and state political leaders, corporations, businesses, and educational institutions to develop and implement quality internet service for virtual learning of the Lumbee Tribal territory (Robeson, Scotland, Hoke, and Cumberland) for the students to receive the quality education they are endowed to receive.
