- 1. Held in contempt;
- 2. Removed from Tribal Council as Speaker and Tribal Council Member;
- 3. Barred from running for Tribal elective office in the 2013 election;
- 4. Barred from running for Tribal elective office in the 2014 election or any special 2014 elections because the returning of Tribal property was not within the 10 day time period as stated under the previous order;
- 5. Pearlean Revels is entitled to any and all others benefits, entitlements, etc., as any other Lumbee Tribal Member, except as withheld above.
