ORIENTATION OF NEW TRIBAL COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVES

WHEREAS, The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina ("Lumbee Tribe") is a recognized American Indian Tribe of the State of North Carolina, subject to the Constitution of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina ("Tribal Constitution") and its inherent powers of self-government;

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 1 of the Tribal Constitution delegates all legislative authority to the Tribal Council of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina ("Tribal Council"); and

THEREFORE, Be it enacted by the Tribal Council of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina this ordinance that shall be cited as **"ORIENTATION OF NEW TRIBAL COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVES."**

1. The Lumbee Tribe (Tribal Council, Executive Branch, Judicial Branch and Elections Board) shall conduct a comprehensive orientation program to prepare new Tribal Council representatives ("representative") to take office;
2. Learning to govern efficiently, ethically, and wisely requires considerable time, effort, and education on the part of the elected representative;
3. Upon certification of election results by the Tribal Elections Board, according to tribal ordinance 2005-0002: **"ELECTION ORDINANCE,"** and/or appointment by Tribal Council to fill a vacant seat on the Tribal Council according to the Tribal Constitution, and, if possible, prior to the swearing-in ceremony, but no later than 30 (thirty) days after being sworn-in, the new representative(s) shall attend said orientation program;
4. The orientation program shall include, but not be limited to, the following subjects:
 - a. Tribal Constitution
 - b. Tribal Legislation
 - c. Tribal Programs, Services, Policies and Procedures
5. The date(s) of the orientation program shall be announced and made available to current representatives. Current representatives shall be encouraged to attend the orientation.
