WHEREAS, The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina ("Lumbee Tribe") is a recognized American Indian Tribe of the State of North Carolina, subject to the Constitution of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina ("Tribal Constitution") and its inherent powers and self-government, and;

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 1 of the Tribal Constitution delegates all legislative authority to the Tribal Council of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina ("Tribal Council"), and;

WHEREAS, The Economic Development Committee is devoted in its efforts to discover and develop means to provide a strong and effective economy for The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina, and;

WHEREAS, The Economic Development Committee has contacted "Blue Stone Strategy" as a research study agency to assist The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina with economic development and promoting economic growth, and;

WHEREAS, The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina supports and agrees to use "Blue Stone Strategy" to conduct research within Lumbee Tribal territory for economic development and for promoting economic growth, and;

WHEREAS, The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina supports and agrees to use "Blue Stone Strategy" to conduct research within Lumbee Tribal territory for economic development and for promoting economic growth, depending upon allocated funds, and Council has requested that The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina's Administration inform Council of funding for economic development and economic growth, and;

THEREFORE, Be it resolved, The Tribal Council of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina supports and agrees to use "Blue Stone Strategy" to conduct research within Lumbee Tribal territory for economic development and for promoting economic growth, and;

THEREFORE, Be it further resolved, The Tribal Council of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina has requested that The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina's Administration inform Council of funding for economic development and economic growth.
