RESOLUTION DESIGNATING DOMINIQUE QUENGA-DIAL AS AN ALTERNATE ADMINISTRATIVE COURT JUDGE

WHEREAS, The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina is governed by the Constitution of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina and the laws enacted by the Tribal Council of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina; and,

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 1 of the Lumbee Constitution vests the legislative authority of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina in the Tribal Council; and,

WHEREAS, Article IX, Section 1 of the Lumbee Constitution authorizes the Tribal Council to establish inferior or lower courts for the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to that constitutional authority, the Tribal Council enacted Tribal Ordinance No. 2004-0003, "Ordinance on the Establishment of an Administrative Court," which is the governing ordinance for the Administrative Court of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina; and,

WHEREAS, Tribal Ordinance No. 2004-0003, as amended, provides that the Administrative Court shall consist of five sitting judges and two alternate judges; and,

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has also adopted ordinances and amendments establishing and updating regional appointment alignments for tribal boards, commissions, and court-related appointments; and,

WHEREAS, the current regional appointment alignment resulted from the restructuring and updating of regional district groupings used for appointments, including Administrative Court-related appointments, in order to maintain proper regional representation following district changes; and,

WHEREAS, the current Administrative Court appointment list reflects that Robie Hunt is assigned to Region 1, with a term expiring February 24, 2027; and,

WHEREAS, the current Administrative Court appointment list further reflects that Dominique Quenga-Dial is also assigned to Region 1, with a term expiring April 17, 2030; and,

WHEREAS, having two sitting Administrative Court judges assigned to the same region creates a regional alignment issue under the current five-region appointment structure; and,

WHEREAS, in order to maintain compliance with the Administrative Court structure of five sitting judges and two alternate judges, and to avoid having two sitting Administrative Court judges assigned to Region 1, the Tribal Council finds it necessary and proper to designate Dominique Quenga-Dial as an Alternate Administrative Court Judge; and,

WHEREAS, this designation preserves Dominique Quenga-Dial's service to the Administrative Court, maintains continuity, and supports compliance with Tribal Ordinance No. 2004-0003 and the current regional appointment alignment; and,

WHEREAS, this Resolution does not amend, revise, or restructure Tribal Ordinance No. 2004-0003, but instead acts pursuant to the authority already provided under the Lumbee Constitution, Tribal Ordinance No. 2004-0003, and the existing regional appointment structure; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina hereby designates Dominique Quenga-Dial to serve as an Alternate Administrative Court Judge for the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina, with her existing term continuing through April 17, 2030, unless otherwise provided by Tribal law; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this designation is necessary to maintain compliance with the Administrative Court structure requiring five (5) sitting judges and two (2) alternate judges and to ensure proper regional alignment under the current appointment structure; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Robie Hunt shall remain the sitting Administrative Court Judge for Region 1, with a term expiring February 24, 2027; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall not be interpreted as an amendment, revision, or restructuring of Tribal Ordinance No. 2004-0003, but solely as an appointment and designation action taken pursuant to existing Tribal law; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Clerk and any other appropriate officials are hereby authorized to update the official Administrative Court appointment records to reflect this designation; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all prior Administrative Court appointment records shall remain valid except to the extent necessary to reflect this designation; and,


BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the Tribal Council.
