## ESTABLISHING THE LUMBEE TRIBE OF NORTH CAROLINA AS LEAD APPLICANT FOR FEDERAL TRIBAL GRANTS AND AUTHORIZING THE RECOVERY OF ADMINISTRATIVE AND INDIRECT COSTS

**WHEREAS**, The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina is the largest tribe east of the Mississippi River and exercises inherent sovereign authority to advance the social, economic, cultural, and governmental interests of its people; and,

**WHEREAS**, Upon federal recognition, the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina will be eligible to apply for and administer federal funding opportunities designated for federally recognized Indian tribes; and,

**WHEREAS**, Various nonprofit organizations, governmental entities, educational institutions, and other agencies may request partnership with the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina in pursuing federal tribal grant opportunities; and


**WHEREAS**, Federal grantmaking requirements under 2 CFR Part 200 permit a lead or prime recipient to recover reasonable and allowable administrative and indirect costs; and,

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, By the Tribal Council of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina that any agency or organization requesting partnership with the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina for a federal tribal grant must submit such request in writing. The Lumbee Tribe shall serve as Lead Applicant, Prime Recipient, and Fiscal Agent. Partnering agencies shall participate as subrecipients or pass-through entities and shall execute a written Subaward/Subrecipient outlining roles, responsibilities, goals, and compliance requirements; and,

**THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina is authorized to retain administrative and/or indirect costs in accordance with 2 CFR Part 200 to support grant management, compliance, reporting, and oversight. All administrative and indirect costs shall be clearly disclosed in the grant budget and narrative. The Tribal Chairman/Chairwoman or designee is authorized to execute all documents consistent with this ordinance.




