



The Lumbee Tribal Scholarship Award 2024

Opens on May 31st and the deadline is July 1, 2024

1. The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina will be awarding scholarships to current college students enrolled for next semester and entering freshman. Applications will be competitive. Scholarships will be awarded to students attending a technical, two or four-year college, or university.
2. Professional individuals in the field of education will weigh academic achievement, grade point average (*minimum of 3.0*), **Native American cultural involvement, career plans, extracurricular activities, community involvement, and your essay for the award.**
3. **Applications must be received between May 31st through July 1, 2024.**
4. Applications will be accepted by mail or you may hand deliver the completed application to the Tribal Complex in a sealed envelope. Applications **MUST** be accompanied with an **official transcript signed by a guidance counselor or the institutions designee in its own sealed envelope and postmarked no later than July 1, 2024.** Official transcripts may also be sent **via e-transcripts (copy of transcripts from student are not considered official)** to Bbrewer@lumbeetribe.com on or before the deadline date of July 1, 2024. 6. Applicants may apply annually.

Explain your answer in detail. This essay should contain **at least 250 words, typed, 12 font, double-spaced, and Times New Roman)**.
3. A copy of a letter of admission/acceptance and class schedule from a college, university, or Certificate of Enrollment for the upcoming school year if currently enrolled.
4. A copy of the active Tribal membership card used for the application.
5. Application must be **postmarked no later than July 1, 2024.**
